COVID - 19 MODIFICATION OF EXCEPTIONAL CREDIT PROTECTION MEASURES

On the 31st of December 2020, Decree-Law no. 107/2020, which introduced changes to the exceptional credit protection measures for families, companies, private charitable institutions, and other social economy entities in the context of the Covid-19 disease pandemic, was published. This Decree-Law came into force on the 1st of January 2021, amending Decree-Law no. 10-J/2020, of the 26th of March¹.

Recognising the impacts of the second wave of the Covid-19 disease pandemic, the European Banking Authority has reactivated the banking moratoriums, **allowing further accessions until the 31st of March 2021** and for a moratorium period of up to nine months from the date of accession.

Entities that could benefit from exceptional credit protection measures for families, companies, private charitable institutions and other social economy entities in the context of the Covid-19 disease pandemic on the 1st of October 2020 and that are not covered by any of the support measures provided for under Decree-Law No 10-J/2020, of the 26th of March, may access the credit moratorium under the following terms:

- 1. The accession must be communicated by the **31st of March 2021**;
- 2. The period of application of the measures **may not exceed nine months from the date of communication of accession**;
- **3.** On the 1st of January 2021, the entity should not have been delayed or in default for more than 90 days and should not be in a state of bankruptcy, suspension, cessation of payments or under an enforcement procedure;
- **4.** The entity must have a settled situation with the Tax and Customs Authority and Social Security, being able to settle that situation by the date of accession.
